#### His Name is Exalted!

Isaiah 12:4 "And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted."

The *twelfth chapter* of the Book of Isaiah is a prophecy of our present day, including charges given us. God was "angry with me", as a matter-of-fact, "God is angry *with the wicked* every day" (*Psalms 7:11*). Now that I'm saved, His anger is turned away from me and He comforts me with the Holy Ghost (*John 14:26*). I now, with joy, can draw water out of the wells (*plural*) of salvation. I can utilize the anointing and understanding of the Word of God from my local assembly. This is the day where we are told to say, "Praise the LORD" – we are to charge one another to give God praise. We are further told to "call upon his name" and to "declare his doings among the people" – testify! We are likewise to "make mention that his name is exalted". Let us not fail this charge – we **must** make mention that His name is exalted!

There are many who "loveth to have the preeminence" (3 John 1:9), and therefore fail to recognize men and women of God who are indeed greater than they. As proud as this is, there's a worse catastrophe than this, "men shall be lovers of their own selves" and "lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God" (2 Timothy 3:1-4). Instead of making mention that Jesus' name is exalted, "They are of the world: therefore **speak they of the world.**.." (1 John 4:5). Many spend their time speaking about everything other than the name of Jesus.

What name is it that has been exalted? It is the name which was kept secret (Judges 13:8). It is the name of the Father and of the Son (Proverbs 30:4). It is the name that Stephen called upon, when calling on God (Acts 7:59). Isaiah put it thus — "The LORD JEHO-VAH... is become my salvation". The name JESUS means "Jehovah is Salvation". No wonder the angel said, "...thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21). I can say like Isaiah, "The LORD JEHOVAH is become my salvation", but can say it a lot quicker by using the name "JESUS"!

The name of Jesus is greater than any other name of God and is truly the new name of God for our time. In times past, God revealed Himself as "Elohim" (the Creator), or "El-Shaddai" (the nursing one/the bountiful one), or Jehovah (the covenant making God). How special it was to know God by one of these names, but, when the Word was made flesh, as the Psalmist wrote, "thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name." (*Psalms 138:2*). Jesus Christ, the Word of God, has been magnified above all the names of God. Paul states simply in *Philippians 2:9*, "Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:". There is no other name of God higher than that name of Jesus, "Neither is there salvation **in any other**: for there is **none other name** under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." (*Acts 4:12*).

It is only through the name of Jesus that we obtain remission of sins. Some may object, "What about the blood!?" – Well, both are true, for the Hebrew writer did say "without the shedding of blood is no remission" (*Hebrews 9:22*). This writer will proudly admit that Christ "loved us, and washed us from our sins **in his own blood**" (*Revelation 1:5*). However, God has specific requirements of when the blood is applied. It is only "upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord" (*Acts 15:17*). Remission of sins is applied by calling the name of Jesus upon an individual during water baptism. Even Paul was told – "arise, and be baptized, and **wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord**" (*Acts 22:16*). No wonder he himself would later write that we're "washed... **in the name of the Lord Jesus**" (*I Corinthians 6:11*). It is truly "though his name" that we "receive remission of sins" (*Acts 10:43, John 20:31*). God forgives sins "for his name's sake" (*I John 2:12*) – there is no salvation, no remission of sins, without the name of Jesus.

Truly, "The name of the LORD is a strong tower" (*Proverbs 18:10*), a place of safety for those righteous who will run into it. It was by the name and faith in the name of Jesus Christ, the Holy One of Israel (*Acts 3:14*), that the lame man was made strong. Even this writer recalls, in a time of desperation, calling on the name of Jesus – and watching Jesus allow breath to a premature child. The name of Jesus is truly **Wonderful** (*Isaiah 9:6*).

Let us not forget to mention that His name is exalted.








## Winter Graphing
